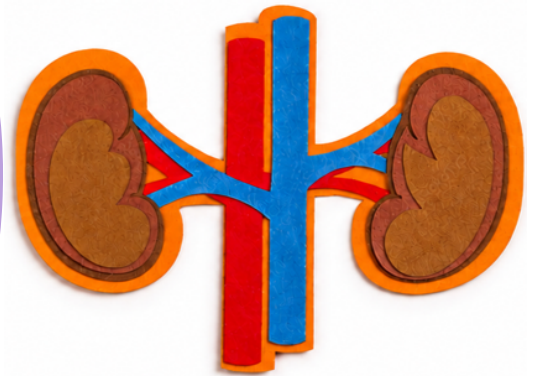

September: Urology Awareness Month

September is Urology Awareness Month, raising awareness of conditions affecting the urinary system in both men and women, as well as male reproductive health.

These include bladder, kidney, prostate, penile and testicular cancers, plus common conditions such as UTIs, urinary incontinence, kidney stones and erectile dysfunction. If you're experiencing symptoms such as blood in your urine, frequent or painful urination, or persistent pelvic or lower back pain, **book an appointment with your GP. Early diagnosis can make a significant difference.**

CHILDHOOD IMMUNISATIONS

Vaccinate to protect your child and others.

Immunisations are safe, effective, and protect against serious diseases. Side effects are usually mild—such as soreness, redness, or fever—and far less severe than the illnesses vaccines prevent. Immunising your child also helps protect vulnerable people around you, including babies and those with weakened immune systems. **Stay on schedule and keep your family safe.**

September is Know Your Numbers Week, a great reminder to check your blood pressure and take charge of your heart health. 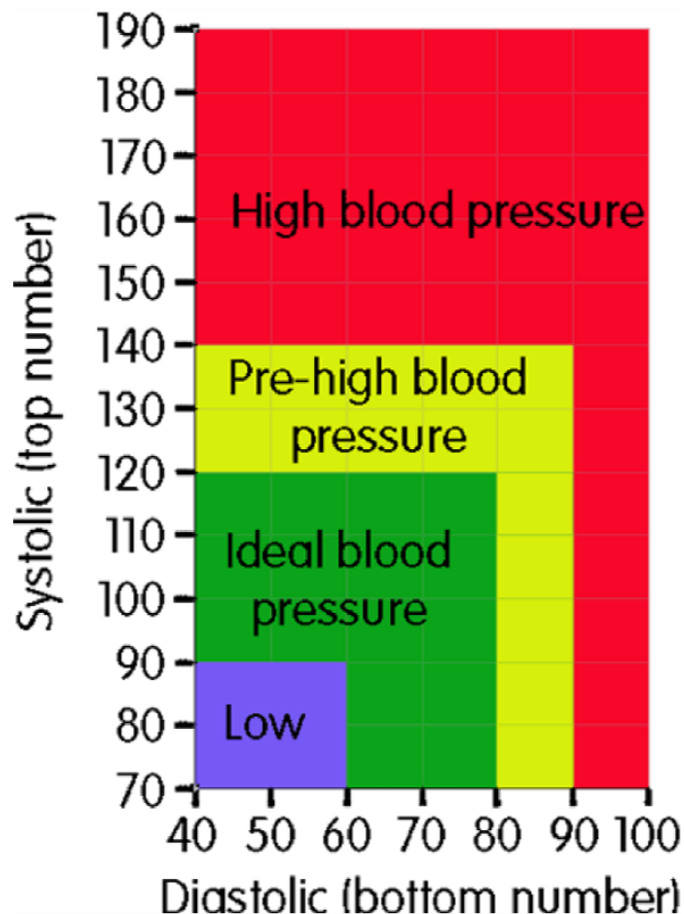
